

A Picasso inspired lesson idea, designed to show students that everybody can draw

Material:

Paper Charcoal Soft Pastels Mirror

Lesson Plan

- 1. Show your students some portraits painted by Picasso
- 2. Talk about that he painted as he saw a person, and it doesn't matter where the eyes are or the nose.
- 3. Talk about that he used vibrant colours, even if they weren't colours you'd find in real faces
- 4. Let them have a look in a mirror
- 5. Every student takes a black charcoal and draws their face on a piece of paper
- 6. In the next step they colour their own portrait
- 7. Let the students show their classmates and and talk about
